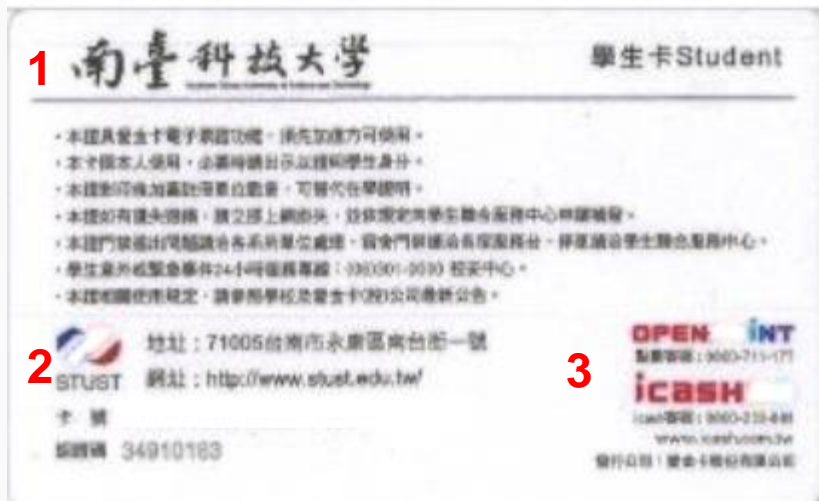

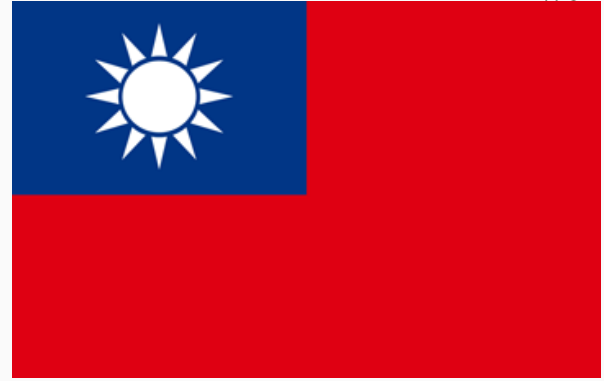
1. Taking public transportation and make payment at stores with either of the card

ID and Visa

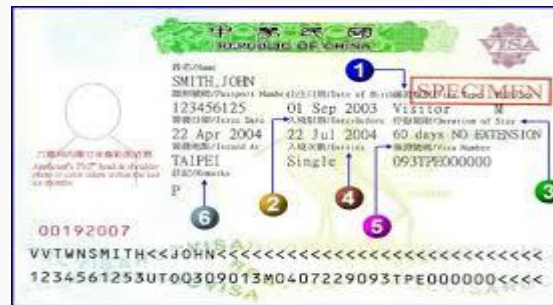
Mind the expiration date of your visa or ARC. **Renew it when needed.**

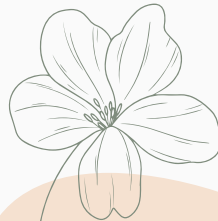

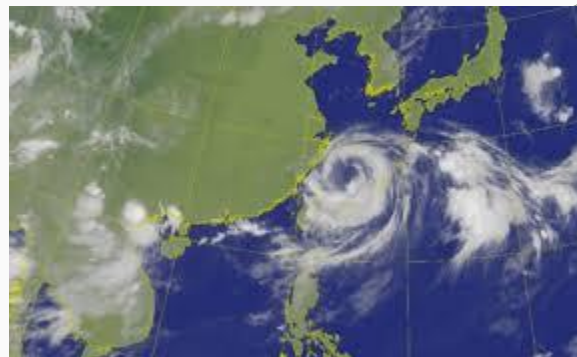
